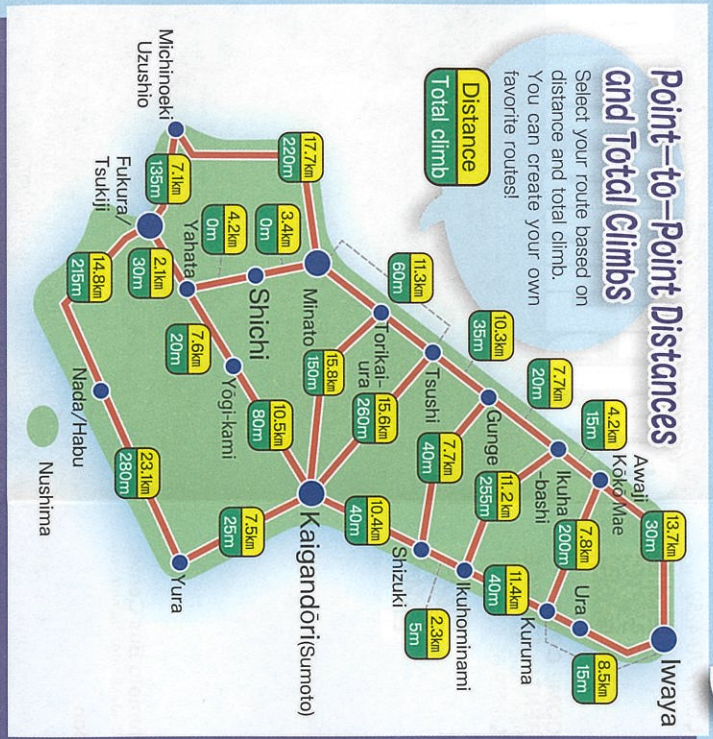


Awaji Island Cycling Map

Parking

As of March, 2023

- Iwaya Port Building Parking**
 - Free up to 1 hr.: 100 yen/hr. thereafter (500 yen/24 hrs)
 - Open 24 hours year round
 - 170 vehicles
- Higashinura Bus Terminal Parking**
 - Free up to 2 hrs.: 500 yen/24 hrs
 - Open 24 hours year round
 - 465 vehicles (including 89 vehicles in No. 2 parking lot)
- Tsuna Port Terminal Parking**
 - Free up to 2 hrs.: 300 yen/24 hrs
 - Open 24 hours year round
 - 242 vehicles
- Sumoto Bus Center Parking**
 - Free up to 1 hr.: 100 yen/hr. thereafter (Max. 600 yen/24 hrs)
 - Open 24 hours year round
 - 451 vehicles
- Suisen'en Parking**
 - Free up to 1 hrs.: 300 yen/24 hrs
 - Open 24 hours year round
 - 120 vehicles
- Wellness Park Parking**
 - Free
 - Open 24 hours year round
 - 150 vehicles
- MinamiAwaji City Cycle Station (Riku no Minato Seidan)**
 - Free
 - Open 24 hours year round
 - 264 vehicles
