The industry has been shifted from mass manufacturing to small-lot of multi kinds products production to create high-valued final products. Tamaki Niime is the foremost artist promoting the integrated manufacturing of "Itten-mono" (=one of a kind) at own company producing to the world.

They are Working on the sustainable community development by utilizing abandoned factories, and "Recovered Fiber" projects.

### Village of Tamba ware, the unique way to inherit the tradition

Tamba ware, one of the Japan Heritage "Six Ancient Kilns" is characterized by its brownish earthy surface and simple texture. Also, the industry has been adapted to the changing lifestyles at times while inheriting its traditions.

The active attitude of adopting new styles without being bound by a single traditional technique and passing it on to the next generation should be a hint for accepting diversity and creating a sustainable community.









## Utilizing the eco energy, "Blanching" in natural hot spring water

The rural natural hot-spring town Yumura. There is an unique sustainable lifestyle living with Onsen water gushing out 470liters/min at 98 centigrade at the center of the village.

Utilizing abundant natural hot spring waters for "Blanching" such as cooking vegetables. The hot spring culture of "Life with Onsen from birth" has rooted in the every household.




### The Origin of Japan Nushima island Onokoro Cruise
















# HYOGO Prefecture is the Best Golf Tourism destination in Japan!






