Compensation Payments for Cooperation in Preventing the Spread of the Novel Coronavirus (2nd Term: Requests Related to Shortened Business Hours after Feb. 8)

Outline

In order to prevent the spread of the novel coronavirus, the prefecture and municipalities will collaborate to make compensation payments to restaurant and food service businesses that have responded to Hyogo Prefecture's request to shorten business hours starting February 8.

Payment details

Eligible applicants

Businesses that operate restaurant or food service facilities that have responded to the prefectural government's request to shorten business hours.

Requirements for payment

Payments will be made to each restaurant or food service facility unit that has cooperated by shortening business hours (including closures and business suspensions) continuously on all business days excluding closed days and other regular holidays of the facility.

- * A poster declaring infection prevention measures must be displayed after implementing infection prevention measures that are based on the industry-specific guidelines. - * It is required that the request be followed continuously from the start date of your cooperation until the end date of the request for shorter hours.
- * Closed days due to regular or irregular holidays are not counted as shortened business days. However, if due to the coronavirus pandemic your restaurant or food service facility was closed on days when it would normally have been open for business, those days will be included.

Documents to be submitted for application

★② A copy of the representative's identity verification document (showing name, date of birth and address) such as a driver's license, Personal Number Card, etc.

^{*} Those who have applied for compensation payments in the first term (following requests to shorten business hours before February 7) will not be required to submit the documents marked with ★ in the list below.

- ★③ Copies of bankbook (1 copy of the cover page and 1 copy of the first two opposing pages spread open)
- ★④ A copy of your most recent tax return (if you haven't filed a tax return soon after opening your business, a copy of 'Notification Concerning the Establishment of Investment Corporation' or 'Notice of Commencement of Business' to the tax office)
 - (5) A copy of the restaurant business license or coffee shop business license in accordance with the Food Sanitation Act.
- ★ ⑥ Documents showing normal business hours (copies of facility's website, flyers and, brochures, photos displaying the facility interior, etc.))
 - ⑦ Photos or copies of the notice of shortened business hours posted in the facility or on the facility's website
- \star (8) Photos of the exterior and interior of the facility showing the name or logo of the facility.
 - (9) Photos that verify that "Declaration of Implementation of Infection Prevention Measures" posters are displayed in or on the facility.
 - (1) (Only if applicable:) Application form and Written Statement of Reason required for obtaining a restaurant business license or a coffee shop business license.

Timing of payment and method of application

The application period is scheduled to start on April 1, 2021. Details of the application processes will be notified as soon as they are confirmed.
